To understand more about how things grow the children will be planting cress seeds in a see through cup so we can watch how the plant grows from seed to stem.

As this falls on a Saturday, we will be celebrating on Monday 25th. Children are invited to wear red for the day and we will be reading the story of St George and building castles using a range of resources, exploring what materials are best to keep the dragon away!

EXPLORING PLANTS AND GROWTH

As you will know, our nursery has been selected to represent England in the World Forum for Early Childhood. We have created a lovely video, showing how we support children to learn about sustainability, and the impact they can have on the world around them. We have been planting lots of lovely flowers and seeds in our garden and the children have thoroughly enjoyed this aspect of learning. We will be continuing this learning as we grow cress seeds and look after them and explore what they need in order to thrive.

So how can you support your children with learning about sustainability?

- **Talk about the importance of putting litter in the bin**
- **Plant seeds at home and learn how to look after them**
- **Encourage your child to help you water plants in the home**
- **Talk about turning off taps and lights to save energy and water**
- **Encourage your child to help you identify which objects can be recycled and talk about the importance of recycling**

A note for home

With the weather being so changeable in the UK, please make sure your child has a coat with them every day. We encourage children to explore outdoors in all weather and having appropriate clothing is essential. Feel free to leave a coat and wellies at nursery if that's easier. Please ensure everything is named.
